National Evangelisation Conference Preparatory Work (Feb. '13 – present)



'The Bishop of Nottingham has hosted a diocesan evangelisation event urging people not to deny others knowledge of the greatest gift there is, by keeping the gift of the Catholic faith to themselves.'

Catholic Bible Sunday 2013 (December '13)

'Speaking ahead of Bible Sunday which falls in the Catholic calendar on 8 December 2013, Bishop Kieran Conry, Chair of the Bishops' Department for Evangelisation and Catechesis, said: "Advent and Christmas can be times of great stress for many people, especially people on low income and with difficult personal relationships. Reading the bible offers an opportunity, first of all, to find a bit of calm space and a way of reflecting on what Christmas is supposed to be."

Evangelii Gaudium Inspires National Gathering of Adult Formators (December '13)

Representatives from a breadth of dioceses met in Hothorpe Hall in Leicestershire 27 – 28 November, just hours after *Evangelii Gaudium* had been released. They spent 24 hours, led by their keynote speaker, Sr Dr Gemma Simmonds CJ, unpacking its content, reflecting too how they might apply what it teaches to their work with parishes."
