# APPEAL TEXT FOR PARISH AMBASSADORS

(Please feel free to adapt.)

### INTRODUCTION

Good Morning / Evening, My name is *(say your name)* and thank you very much to Father *(say his name)* for giving me a brief moment to talk to you about today's celebration of Home Mission Sunday.

### AN URGENT TASK

Today the Bishops of England and Wales ask all of us to consider how we can play our part in the **urgent task** of Catholic evangelisation - the living and sharing of our faith in our families and in our local communities.



#### The reality is that, "many children and young

people today will never see their [Catholic] parents receive the sacraments."<sup>1</sup> I'm sure, like me, you have observed this to be the case first hand, with many of perhaps our own family members, Catholic work colleagues and friends, rarely or never attending Mass, or enjoying any kind of connection with parish life.

In a moment of silence, may I invite you now to bring to mind those people you know to whom this applies. PAUSE FOR A MOMENT OF SILENCE

### NOT ALONE

You may have brought to mind just now, your husband or wife, your son, daughter, grandchildren, niece or nephews, friends and others. You're **not alone.** Research suggests that an estimated 80% of Catholics in England and Wales are non churchgoing (sometimes called 'lapsed') Catholics.

### HOPE

Whilst this is not a new situation, there is **hope.** Every year non churchgoing Catholics in parishes across England and Wales do return to the practice of their faith if invited. The Bishops today ask each one of us to use the opportunities that present themselves, to invite people to re-connect.

### SIMPLE WAYS

Often the turning point for a non churchgoing Catholic comes through a **simple** and authentic encounter. One example of this is found in the story of a young man called Matt who stopped going to Church as a student. He describes himself as: "the perfect example of a lapsed Catholic". One of the significant moments in his journey of return to Faith, came when staying with a cousin, called Janie, who invited him and his wife to say the Rosary with her. Matt says that from that moment: "...it seemed things really took off for both of us. Janie's simple act of seeing the best in us, and not being too scared to spontaneously lead us in prayer, was both brave and inspired." This encounter played a significant part in Matt's return to the practice of the faith, and also in his wife's decision to explore becoming a Catholic.

If you're interested in possibly **starting a parish group** to reach out to and welcome non churchgoing Catholics, please do come and see me after Mass, and / or see Father. (Or if you already have an evangelisation group in the parish, or are involved in an existing diocesan evangelisation project, please use this moment to promote that.)
