# Seeing God in All things

The rationale for the choice of these values is that there is a progression in them which models the spiritual life. They are present in the life of Thérèse and could translate into anyone's life. The model is therefore person-centred rather than abstract and fits very well with the philosophy that every student is different.

The first three are about grounding a student in a healthy and productive life-giving Christian community.

The last four are more challenging and represent a growth in understanding of what it means to live a fully Christian and spiritual life. They point towards a more contemplative development which could feed into the artistic and creative side of school life.
