APPLICATIONS FOR GRANT FUNDING

Applications for grant funding are sought from appropriate organisations in England and Wales for projects supporting the objects of the Trust. Grant awards for 2009-2010 will be made to applicants from those who successfully address the following theme:

Imaginative projects providing education for people from the most marginalised sectors of society

Only projects focussing on adults and those over 16 years will be considered. Bidders will be expected to highlight the extent of the marginalisation addressed by their project. The Grant Making Body will exercise preference for projects that make the greatest impact for the most marginalised in society.

Funding will be for a maximum period of twelve months at up to 100% of project costs. Funding requests should range between £30,000 and £100,000; for exceptional projects the Trust may consider other awards. The Trust will consider applications from organisations seeking to use its grant as match funding as part of a larger project but only if it contributes to an effective delivery of the Trust's objects.
