#### THE WAY WE WELCOME

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) has flourished in the years following the Second Vatican Council. Supported by summer schools in the mid-eighties the RCIA is now an important part of the life of many parishes across the South of England, and the Rite of Election has become a high point in the life of our dioceses.
