Dear Friend,

It is estimated that at least two-thirds of the baptised Catholic community in England and Wales is non churchgoing which equates to approximately four to five million people. This makes for a significant constituency of people who, in most cases, self-identify as Catholic but never or rarely attend Mass.

Recently the Department for Evangelisation and Catechesis initiated a national project to support ministry to this group of people. Following the creation of a national core group and the putting on of a leaders' day in London in March 2011, five resource days for parishioners are now being offered across England and Wales. I'm delighted that Arundel and Brighton Diocese is hosting the day for the Province and that **Archbishop Peter Smith** (Southwark) is able to attend and will preside and preach at the celebration of the Mass. I very much hope that you're able to attend. The event will take place at the Christian Education Centre, 4 Southgate Drive, Crawley, West Sussex on 3rd March 2012, 10am – 4.30pm, with coffee served from 9.30am. Everyone is welcome.

Repeatedly when parishioners are asked about what their key concerns are, they name non churchgoing Catholics (sometimes called 'lapsed Catholics'). The resource day in Crawley - which is being run in partnership with the Arundel and Brighton Diocesan Team and the Bishops' Conference Home Mission Desk - aims to offer information about resources and initiatives to help us reach out to non churchgoing Catholics. The programme (below) will allow attendees to explore the issues, share experiences and receive information about resources.
