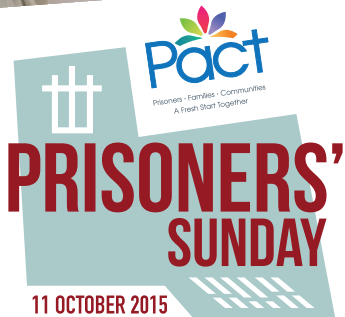

Today is Prisoners' Sunday

As a Church we are asked to pray especially for those who are affected by imprisonment. It is estimated that 200,000 children are affected by parental imprisonment across England and Wales. Imprisonment has a rippling effect encompassing the Prisoner's wider family. Often when a Parent is imprisoned the children are twice as likely to experience behavioural and mental health problems, and are less likely to do well at school.



How you can help:

The Prison Advice & Care Trust is the only national Catholic charity in England & Wales that works solely with those who are affected by imprisonment. Pact works with Prisoner's, their families, and with ex-offenders once they have been released.
