

Since 2000, the dioceses of England and Wales have been running a propadeutic year at the Royal English College seminary in Valladolid. This is a one year seminary program of formation and continuing discernment.

The number of men starting the propadeutic year are shown here for those interested in the propadeutic year.

Official released statistics for new seminarians <u>only</u> refer to the number starting at diocesan seminary (column 2) so that men who transfer to diocesan seminary after the propadeutic year are only counted once.
