Introduction

Pope Benedict XVI has announced that a Year of Faith will begin on 11 October 2012, ending on 24 November 2013, the Feast of Christ the King. One of the emphases of the Year is to offer initiatives that support the work of evangelisation – particularly through charitable works. In support of the Year, Little Way Week has as its focus the teaching of St Thérèse of Lisieux which affirms that we grow in holiness and witness to God's love doing little things for love of Him and others every day. This leaflet offers an overview of the initiative and the resources for secondary schools.
